- application;
- transcripts;
- letter of professional intent;
- Two letters of recommendation;
- resume/CV
- additional supporting documents (i.e. additional list of courses, certifications, etc.)

You must submit your application following the application sequence above. Additional or edited documents will not be accepted once the initial application and supporting documents have been received and logged into roster of applicants.

A scholarship application is complete and valid only when the IFMA Foundation receives the emails with the PDF file (including all supporting documents) and a high-resolution photo no later than 11:59 PM on **April 30, 2019**.

## **Deniz-Besiktepe-Karaman**

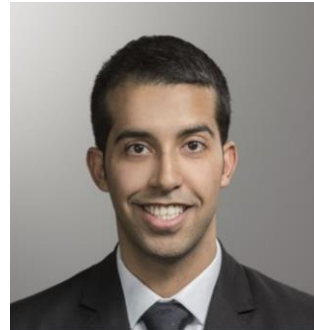
